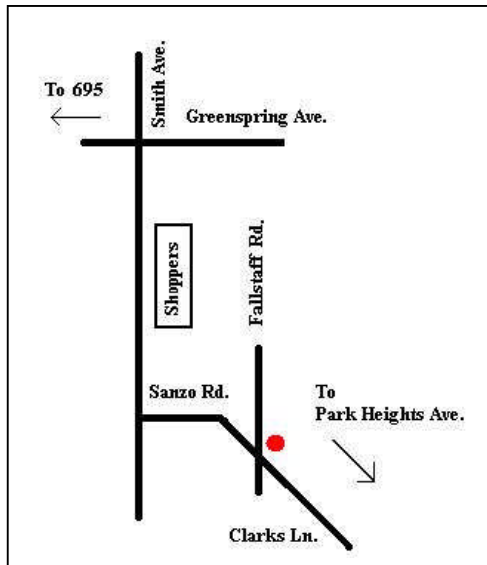


Our congregation is:
