Erev Rosh Hashanah - Friday, Sept. 18: Ma'ariv: 6:30pm. The service is expected to be approximately 45 min, including short remarks by the Rabbi who will introduce some themes which he will be returning to during the balance of the High Holidays.

1st day Rosh Hashanah - Saturday, Sept. 19: Shacharit: 8:30am. No Mincha or Ma'ariv.

2nd day Rosh Hashanah - Sunday, September 20: Shacharit 8:30am, Mincha 5:00pm, followed by Tashlich at the Western Run stream.(10 minute walk from shul)

Kol Nidre: Sunday, Sept. 27, at 6:15pm

Yom Kippur: Monday, September 28, 9:00am
